New UUFC Justice Outreach Fund

The UUFC maintains a fund – the Charitable and Educational Outreach Fund for Social Justice, referred to as the Justice Outreach Fund – for grants that are focused on high-impact projects aimed at seeding and achieving social, economic, racial, environmental and other kinds of justice. The Grant Committee is pleased to announce the launch of a pilot grant program to make some initial small grants from this fund. The Grant Committee will review completed grant applications received before January 31 for small grants up to \$500.
