*Number 6.8* POLICY ON TRANSPORTATION FOR UUFC RELATED EVENTS

PURPOSE

To outline the requirements for transportation of children and youth to UUFC sponsored events.

BACKGROUND

Opportunities for social service, community events, conferences and field trips outside of UUFC grounds can be valuable experiences for children and youth participating in RE programs.

POLICY

1. Any volunteer driver for a UUFC-sponsored event must sign a "Private Transportation Guidelines" form, provide a copy of their license and current auto insurance card annually.
2. All volunteer drivers will have their driving record checked annually. Drivers with significant moving violations will not be allowed to be volunteer drivers.
3. Volunteer drivers transporting youth to district or continental events must be at least 24 years of age.
4. Volunteer drivers transporting children and youth to local events must be 18 years of age or older.
5. Parents or guardians may make private arrangements for transportation of their child or youth if desired.
6. On those occasions when UUFC rents a vehicle for a UUFC sponsored event, the volunteer driver's insurance will be used as the primary insurance in the event of an accident and the UUFC's insurance will be used as the secondary insurance.
