FAIR SHARE GIVING GUIDE

The Unitarian Universalist Association encourages UU members to aspire toward proportional giving, or tying your annual support for your congregation to your annual income, as both a spiritual practice and a way to support thriving congregations. The worksheet and chart below are intended to assist you in considering a Fair Share commitment for 2017-18.

Step 1: ANNUAL INCOME

Do you earn income through a regular paycheck? Pension payments? Other sources? You can determine your annual income either by referring back to last year's income tax statement or your most recent paystub(s).

Step 2: SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Each of us has unique circumstances impacting our finances. Are you expecting unusual or periodic income, such as through a business you own, the sale of investments or property, or other sources? Are you facing large medical expenses, caring for parents, or putting children through school? We encourage you to factor those circumstances in as you consider your potential support for UUFC.

Step 3: COMMITMENT LEVEL

Consider your values and relationship to the Fellowship in thinking about your financial commitment to UUFC, as expressed by the levels below. Note that within each commitment level, the guide is progressive, with giving levels rising with financial capacity.

SUPPORTER: The congregation is a significant part of my spiritual and intellectual life that I want to support.

SUSTAINER: The congregation is my central community; I am committed to sustaining the programs and ministries of my congregation.

VISIONARY: My commitment is a clear demonstration of the unique importance of this congregation and of my spiritual principles.

TRANSFORMER: I am deeply committed to the congregation; my contribution provides fuel for transformation and is part of my spiritual practices in living out my UU Principles.
