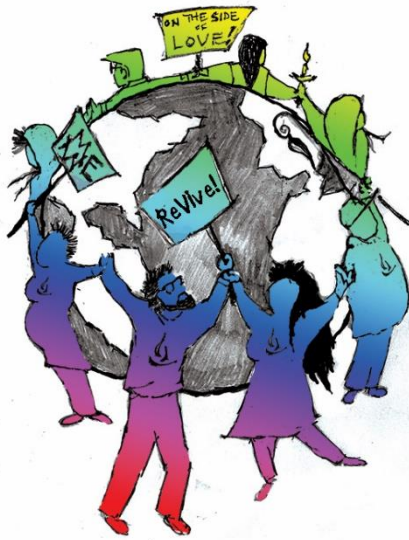


# ReVive Retreat For Social Justice Activists

April 28-30, 2017

Shalom Prayer Center, Mt. Angel, Oregon



This retreat will provide an opportunity for social justice advocates/activists within the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Corvallis to gather for respite, renewal, and connection through facilitated activities, reflection, and silence.

The retreat will take place at the beautiful Shalom Prayer Center in Mt. Angel, Oregon, about 55 miles from Corvallis.

**Facilitator:** Rev. Lindi Ramsden is Acting Dean of Students and Community Life and Visiting Assistant Professor of Faith and Public Life at Starr King School for the Ministry. She has extensive experience in spiritually grounded justice ministries, making significant contributions to the movements to secure marriage equality for same-sex couples, establish the human right to water, pass health care reform, and advance immigrant rights. She is an advocate for increased collaboration with and among national UU justice partners. She is committed to engaging the climate crisis from an environmental justice lens.

**Transportation:** The ReVive planning committee is arranging for bus transportation. We respectfully request that you take advantage of it to help minimize our use of fossil fuels.

**Accommodations:** The ReVive Retreat includes lodging for 2 nights in a single room, six meals, and an opportunity to create a Retreat weekend of your choosing.

**Registration:** The registration fee is on a sliding scale, from \$130 to \$170. Scholarships are available, and no one will be turned away for lack of funds.

Your received payment will confirm your reservation. Please register by **April 10**. You may also choose to donate an additional amount to help subsidize scholarships. Space is limited to 30 participants, so register soon. There will be a waiting list of registrations received after all spaces are full.
