Parent Orientations for Our Whole Lives (OWL) sexuality education classes are happening at the Fellowship today:

~K-1st Grade OWL - 12:30-2 upstairs in the RE wing of the Fellowship.
For 7th/8th/9th Grade OWL - 12:30-3:30 in room 7.
For 10th/11th/12th OWL - 9 - 11 AM in room 7.

Childcare for young children will be provided during the orientations. Older youth are welcome to bring quiet activities and food to occupy themselves with during the orientations. A light finger-food buffet will be provided. These orientations provide parents with the opportunity to learn about the OWL curriculum, meet the teachers, get the schedule of sessions, ask questions, and register their children and/or youth. Parents are required to attend an orientation prior to registering their children and youth.

There is no cost for OWL, for members of the Fellowship. Non-members are also welcome to participate for a small fee. Full scholarships are available based on need, such as public assistance, WIC, Oregon Trail SNAP or TANF.

OWL sessions will begin in January of 2018.

Thus far, the soils engineering report and the boundary and topographic survey have been completed.
