Emergency Aid Fund Policy 2.11

Purpose:

The Emergency Aid Fund of the UU Fellowship of Corvallis (the "Fund") exists to provide basic and appropriate emergency financial aid to UU Fellowship of Corvallis (the "UUFC" or the "Fellowship") members and friends in need.

Scope:

The Fund is a sub-fund of the Minister's Discretionary Fund.

The Fund is for relatively small but vital financial assistance for members and friends of the congregation who encounter one-time, unforeseen or unexpected financial need.

The Fund is not a source for on-going financial support and is not intended as a general community resource.

Policy:

UUFC maintains an Emergency Aid Fund as a sub-fund of the Minister's Discretionary Fund.

The Emergency Aid Fund is administered by the Emergency Aid Fund Committee which is appointed by the UUFC senior minister.

Distributions from the Fund will not exceed the available amount in the Fund.

No funds will directly benefit the minister or the minister's family.

Fund requests and requestor details are confidential and are stored in accordance with the UUFC confidential document storage and archival policy.
