

Policy 8.7 EXTERIOR SIGN POSTING

The policy applies to signs to be posted longer than seven (7) days.

All posting of exterior signs must comply with any State of Oregon, Benton County or City of Corvallis rules or regulations in effect at the time of posting.

Any sign which relates to a "momentous issue" decision by a super-majority vote of the congregation will include a citation of the appropriately relevant phrase as stated in our UU Principles so that it is evident that the stand taken on an issue is a reflection of our core values.

Any sign for the purpose of stating a congregational stand on an issue will have a pre-determined time limit for display with a maximum limit on display of 90 days.

The UUFC Board of Directors must approve, by simple majority, the hanging, erection, creation or otherwise posting of any exterior sign(s) on the Fellowship property.

The Board has pre-approved the following exterior signs:

1. The large wooden permanent sign directly in front of the Fellowship stating "Unitarian Universalist Fellowship."
2. The UUFC permanent Parking sign located in front of the Fellowship.
3. The permanent "enter" and "exit" signs located on Firwood Street adjacent to the parking lot driveways.
4. A "for sale, lease or rent" sign placed at the adjacent owned dwelling.
5. The annual "Rummage Sale" and "Holiday Bazaar" signs.
6. Handicap parking signs.
7. Short term signs (1-2 days) announcing events being held at the Fellowship.

In emergency situations brought about by issues that call for an immediate public response, then any sign may be displayed (subject to paragraphs 2 & 3 above) if approved by the Minister. In the Minister's absence, then the Board President can approve; in the President's absence, the Board Vice-President.
