Thank you for supporting Linn Benton Food Share. Together, we provided over 4.9 million pounds of food to our neighbors in need. By itself, that is no small feat. But with your support, we achieved so much more.

2019 Highlights

- 4.9 million pounds of food distributed – equal to 138 semi-trucks.
- Support for 68 local nonprofits in Linn & Benton Counties.
- Emergency Food Pantries distributed 46,041 food boxes - Up 4% from 2018.
- 25% of all food pounds distributed was fresh produce.
- Monthly support for 350 low-income seniors through the Commodity Supplemental Food Program.
- Outreach to low-income, marginalized communities traditionally not accessing emergency food.
- Partnered with Samaritan Albany and Lebanon Hospitals to provide healthy food to low income, food insecure patients after discharge to help them heal at home.
- The LBFS network of partner agencies utilized 190,000 hours of volunteerism – equivalent to 91 full-time workers!

Hunger must be addressed in both the immediate and long term. Your support provides food for today and the necessary investments for tomorrow.

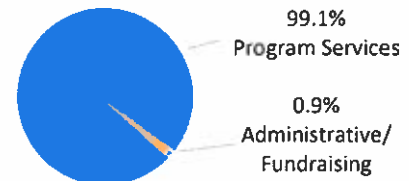

Dear Rev. McAllister,



This barrier can be particularly hard to overcome during times of uncertainty, like we are currently experiencing. Because of your thoughtful donation, CARDV has been able to continue to help survivors like Sally* overcome this barrier and maintain safe housing and supportive services.

After leaving her abuser, Sally needed rental assistance while she worked with her employer to obtain more hours at work. She worked with CARDV's Housing Advocate to budget plan and stay in good standing with her landlord in order to maintain a safe home for her and her children.
