Request for use of UUFC facilities by UUFC groups during pandemic conditions

December 2021

Starting January 1, 2022, the UUFC welcomes back UUFC groups to use the UUFC social hall or sanctuary for small group gatherings. We've learned that the threat of infection is not going away, but can be managed. Five management controls (especially when used together in 'layers') have proven the most effective in reducing the likelihood of Covid spread: vaccinations, masking, social distancing, air quality control, and surface hygiene.

For these gatherings, the following minimum protocols must be met:

- All attendees must provide proof of vaccination or a negative Covid-test within three days of the start of each event
- Group size will be limited to 40 persons in the sanctuary and 15 in the social hall to reduce the potential for a mass-spread event
- Attendees must be masked
- Attendees must remain at least 7 feet apart. If activities include physical exertion 10 feet is suggested
- Singing quietly with masks on is permitted as long as distance is maintained.
- One person takes responsibility for seeing that all safety practices are followed, takes roll of all attendees, and reports on attendees to the UUFC. A link to a form will be provided when a reservation is approved.
- All furniture is returned to its starting location and commonly touched non-porous surfaces such as door knobs are sanitized at the end of the event
- Hands are washed and bathrooms surfaces are sanitized after each use, and after the event is over (toilet, sink, doorknobs)
- Attendees understand that the risk of Covid transmission is not zero under these conditions
