

Eliot Institute Camp Scholarship Applications

We are seeking applications from UUFC families for scholarship funds to attend an Eliot Institute camp, located at Seabeck Washington, in 2026. Eliot Institute is a non-profit organization whose mission is to operate camps promoting personal and spiritual growth for Unitarian Universalists, their families, and friends. Scholarship funds are made available through earnings on UUFC endowment funds. These scholarships are available to all families, regardless of financial means. In our allocation process we will give priority to families with greatest need, *but we want to spend these funds*. The intent for use of our endowment fund earnings is to “ensure the long-term, intergenerational vitality of the UUFC.” We can think of no better way to do such than supporting families and connections among UUFC families in activities that build our communities, both within UUFC and the broader Unitarian Universalist community.

Available Funds: \$3,800

Applications:

A 1-2 page application is to be submitted. It must include answers to these questions:

1. Who are you? Please provide name, address, email, and phone contact information for all members of your family.
2. What are your ties to the UUFC?
3. Which Eliot camp do you plan to attend? There are two seven-night camps: July 11-18 and August 1-8; these usually have up to 40% children and youth attending. There are also two four-night camps, held Aug 8-12 and Dec 28-Jan 1, with fewer children/youth. Use this link to view information about upcoming camps – [Eliot camps 2026](#). 4. What level of scholarship support will you need for your family to be able to attend a camp? The application review team has access to or information about other resources for camp attendance, so please list a support amount that will truly help you consider camp participation.
5. What else should the application review team know about you and your family?

Proposal Submission: Please submit your proposal as PDF or Word document. Send as an email to dre@uucorvallis.org, drop off or mail a hard copy to the UUFC office (2945 NW Circle Blvd, Corvallis OR 97330) or give it to DRE Skyla. Applications must be submitted by March 9, 2026.

Proposal review: Your proposal will be reviewed by an endowment review team. Funding decisions will be made by March 17, 2026.
